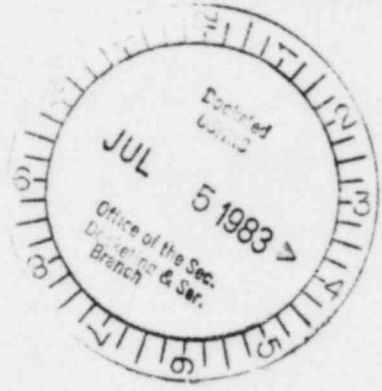

I have received a copy of a draft letter to Chairman Palladino of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and Lt. General Griffith of the Defense Nuclear Agency regarding the re-licensing of AFRR1 nuclear reactor.

I wholeheartedly support this action by the Council and the Executive to recommend procedures by which the health and safety of Montgomery County citizens may be protected.

I have supported the efforts of the Citizens for Nuclear Reactor Safety to have their concerns addressed in the re-licensing process. I am pleased that the county is continuing those efforts.

The requests made in the draft letter for a 10-year license renewal, a monitoring procedure, an additional member of the oversight committee and an emergency plan seem to me to be entirely reasonable. I sincerely hope that the NRC and DNA respond appropriately.
