

SUBJECT: FEMA FINAL DRILL REPORTS FOR THE APRIL 29, 1992,
WASHINGTON STATE LABORATORY DRILL AND THE MAY 6, 1992,
OREGON STATE LABORATORY DRILL

Enclosed are two letters from Dennis Kwiatkowski of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The first is dated June 17, 1992, transmitting the subject report for the Washington State Laboratory Drill, and the second is dated July 1, 1992, transmitting the subject report for the Oregon State Laboratory Drill.

No Deficiencies or Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) were identified during either of these drills. There were, however, some "plan issues" identified during these drills. FEMA's Region X Staff has reviewed these findings with the respective States and will continue to monitor progress on these findings to assure that corrective actions are taken on or before the agreed upon dates.

Please forward a copy of the enclosed FEMA letter and drill report to the respective licensees and request that the licensees follow up with offsite officials on the "plan issues."
