

AMENDMENT NO. I

* and, as of August 1, 1977, the amount available as secondary financial protection.

Item 5 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is amended by adding the following:

Nuclear Energy Liability Policy (Facility Form) No. MF-113 issued by Mutual Atomic Energy Liability Underwriters.


