We have reviewed your reply and find it responsive to the concerns raised in our Notice of Violation. This item was discussed in a meeting on January 31, 1985, between our resident inspectors and Mr. J. M. Levine and other members of your staff. In response to Mr. Johnson's comment that more generic action to prevent recurrence would be appropriate in this case, Mr. Levine stated that this would be considered and that more had been done than was stated in your letter of January 28, 1985. We will review the implementation of your corrective actions during a future inspection to determine that full compliance has been achieved and will be maintained.
