This refers to the inspection conducted by D. Hills, C. Phillips, M. Peck, P. Lougheed, R. Elliott, and G. Replogle of this office, and by J. Roman of the Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety, on June 3 through July 20, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your LaSalle County Station, Units 1 and 2, facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in solation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation is of concern as the multiple examples represent a large of plant worker emphasis on fire protection program implementation.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should "ument the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan!" recent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including our proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the "will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosures, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by $t^{\rm t}$. Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
