ORDER

On August 14, 1984 the Union of Concerned Scientists (LCS) requested the Commission to expunge or modify a footnote in the Commission's Order of August 6, 1984 (unpublished). That footnote stated that UCS has forfeited its right to participate as a party on management issues, but was being allowed to participate on those issues as a matter of discretion.

The Commission finds it unnecessary at this time to consider further the formal party status of UCS on management issues. UCS is being allowed to participate as a matter of discretion and has not shown any prejudice by the characterization of its participation as
discretionary. UCS therefore has no basis to complain of its treatment, and the UCS Motion is accordingly denied. ${ }^{1}$

Chairman Palladino disapproved this order.
