SUBJECT: ENVIRONMENTAL QUALIFICATION (EQ) JUSTIFICATION
FOR CONTINUED OPERATION (JCO)

Re: Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit 1

By letter dated March 23, 1984 you documented the discussions held at the February 2, 1984 meeting with the staff regarding EQ of equipment for Brunswick Units 1 and 2. In that letter you reaffirmed the JCOs previously submitted for both units.

In our review of the Unit 2 extension request, we found that there were questions regarding some of those JCOs and further information was needed to determine the acceptability. In a meeting on September 20, 1984 the NRC staff and the CP&L staff met to resolve the questions regarding the Unit 2 JCOs. This issue was resolved prior to startup of Unit 2 from the current outage.

The September 20, 1984 meeting and an additional submittal resolved the questions regarding Unit 2 JCOs. However, there is some equipment in Unit 1 for which there are JCOs that have not been reviewed. These JCOs need to be reviewed in the same manner as those for Unit 2 at the September 20, 1984 meeting. We request that you review the aforementioned JCOs for Unit 1 and confirm their acceptability on the same basis as those for Unit 2.

This information should be submitted under oath or affirmation within 30 days of receipt of this letter.
