
NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF SAETY EVALUATION REPORT

Notice is hereby given that the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation has published its Safety Evaluation Report on the proposed operation of Hope Creek Generating Station located on the Delaware River Estuary in Lower Alloways Creek Township, Salem County, New Jersey. Notice of receipt of the application of Public Service Electric and Gas Company to operate Hope Creek Generating Station was published in the Federal Register on August 10, 1983 (48 F. R. 36357-36358).
