Dear Mr. Youngblood:

Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 3 Application for Amendment to Construction Permit No. CPPR-113, As Amended

In Reference (1), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) requested an exemption from the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix A General Design Criterion (GDC) 4 as it relates to the dynamic effects associated with the reactor coolant system main loop pipe breaks. Reference (2) modified the exemption request to exclude the reactor coolant pump P-1 snubber supports from consideration.

NNECO hereby requests that CPPR-113 be amended to reflect the exemption requested in References 1 and 2 upon its issuance.

Specifically, we request that Paragraph 3 of the construction permit be amended to read, in part, as follows:

"This permit shall be deemed to contain and be subject to the conditions specified in Section 50.54 and 50.55 of said regulations; is subject to all applicable provisions of the act, and rules, regulations, and order of the Commission now or hereafter in effect as modified 13001 W/check \$ 150 by duly authorized exemptions;..."

We also request that paragraph 3.c of the construction permit be revised to read, in part, as follows:

"...construct the facility described in the application (as modified by duly authorized exemptions) and in the hearing record, in accordance..."

Pursuant to 10 CFR 170.12(c), we have enclosed a check in the amount of \$150.00 as payment of the application fee.
