DEAR MR. KACICH,

THANK YOU FOR THE MEETING AND PRESENTATION HELD ON JULY 15, 1992 AT THE MILLSTONE SIMULATOR BUILDING CONCERNING MILLSTONE IT. YOUR PRESENTATION WAS MOST INFORMATIVE AND HELPFUL.

YOUR AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE US WITH INFORMATION ABOUT THE AMOUNT OF RADIOACTIVITY (IN CURIES PER ISOTOPE) IN A TYPICAL ASSEMBLY THAT HAS UNDERGONE 85% BURNUP WILL HELP THE PUBLIC TO UNDERSTAND THE POTENTIAL RISKS IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT.

ADDITIONALLY, YOUR AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE US WITH THE ACTUAL CALCULATIONS DONE BY YOUR COMPANY, ABB-CE, AND HOLTEC IN FINDING THE DESIGN ERRORS RELATED TO KEFF, AND THOSE CALCULATIONS AND ASSUMPTIONS USED IN THE REDESIGN TO BRING THE MILLSTONE II SPENT FUEL POOL KEFF SAFETY MARGINS BACK INTO COMPLIANCE WITH NRC REGULATIONS WILL ASSIST OUR EXPERTS IN REVIEWING POSSIBLE DANGER FROM CRITICALITY OCCURRING IN THE SPENT FUEL POOL.

YOUR WILLINGNESS TO HAVE OUR EXPERTS COMMUNICATE DIRECTLY WITH YOUR EXPERTS IS ALSO GREATLY APPRECIATED. WE ALSO APPRECIATE YOUR WILLINGNESS TO CONSIDER THE INSTALLATION OF AN 800 NUMBER FOR PUBLIC INFORMATION ABOUT THE PLANNED AND UNPLANNED RELEASES OF RADIOACTIVITY. WE FEEL THIS WILL HELP A GREAT DEAL IN BUILDING A BETTER RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN YOUR COMPANY AND THE COMMUNITIES YOU SERVE.

WE ALSO APPRECIATE YOUR CONSENT TO BRING TO YOUR BOARD OUR REQUEST THAT NEUTRON FLUX MONITORS BE PLACED IN THE MILLSTONE II POOL, OR YOUR OLDEST POOL CONTAINING BOROFLEX. THIS WILL ALSO HELP THE PUBLIC AND SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY TO UNDERSTAND THE REALITIES OF ANY CRITICALITY ISSUES CONCERNING THE POOL.

YOUR CONSIDERATION OF RELEASING METEOROLOGICAL DATA DAILY FROM YOUR TWO ON SITE TOWERS DIRECTLY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION METEOROLOGICAL DATA DIVISION*CAN ONLY FURTHER HELP YOUR EFFORTS TO BE A GOOD CORPORATE NEIGHBOR.

WE ALSO HOPE YOU WILL VERY SERIOUSLY CONSIDER THE CONCERNS PRESENTED TO YOU AT THE MEETING BY MR. JAY SULLIVAN OF WATERFORD, ESPECIALLY THE CONCERNS ABOUT THE EVACUATION PLANS AND HIS NEED FOR INFORMATION.

WE, ALONG WITH OTHER ORGANIZATIONS, ALSO CONSIDERED YOUR REQUEST TO WITHDRAW OUR REQUEST FOR A HEARING BEFORE THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD. THE CONSENSUS IS THAT WE FEEL WE SHOULD CONTINUE WITH THIS PURSUIT FOR THE PRESENT TIME. HOWEVER, WE MOST CERTAINLY AGREE WITH YOU THAT WE SHOULD KEEP THE LINES OF COMMUNICATION OPEN AND HOPEFULLY WE CAN COME TO AN AGREEMENT THAT WILL ADDRESS OUR CONCERNS. SHOULD THAT HAPPEN, WE MOST LIKELY WOULD BE WILLING TO WITHDRAW FROM ANY ACTIONS CURRENTLY BEFORE THE NRC.

WE EAGERLY AWAIT YOUR TRANSMITTAL TO US OF THE INFORMATION AGREED UPON. OUR EXPERTS LOOK FORWARD TO REVIEWING IT.

AGAIN, THANK YOU FOR THE MEETING AS WELL AS YOUR KIND CONSIDERATION IN OTHER MATTERS OF MUTUAL INTEREST.
