DEAR SECRETARY: *Docket# 50-336-01A-ASLBP 92-665-02-01A

PLEASE ACCEPT THIS AS MY WRITTEN REQUEST FOR A HEARING AND INTERVENOR STATUS ON DOCKET #50-336* NOTICED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ON 28 APRIL 1992, AT WHICH TIME THE NRC ANNOUNCED THEIR PROPOSED DECISION TO RULE THAT THE LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUESTED BY NORTHEAST UTILITIES (NORTHEAST NUCLEAR ENERGY COMPANY) FOR THE REDESIGN OF THE MILLSTONE II NUCLEAR POWER PLANT SPENT FUEL POOL DOES NOT INVOLVE A SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS RISK.

I FEEL THAT SIGNIFICANT RISK MAY BE PRESENT AND REQUEST THAT YOU DO NOT ALLOW YOUR RULING ON JUNE 4, 1992 OF NO SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS TO PERMIT NORTHEAST UTILITIES TO USE THAT SPENT FUEL POOL UNTIL HEARINGS ARE HELD AND SAFEGUARDS CAN BE PUT IN PLACE TO INSURE THAT NO INADVERTENT CRITICALITY OR LOSS OF COOLANT WATER WILL LEAD TO A LOSS OF CONTAINMENT AND LARGE EXPOSURES OF RADIOACTIVITY TO THE POPULATION.

I REQUEST THAT YOU HOLD THE PUBLIC HEARINGS IN NEW LONDON COUNTY, CONNECTICUT WHERE THE NUCLEAR PLANT IS LOCATED.

I AM ALSO REQUESTING THAT, UNDER THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT, YOU CONDUCT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STUDY TO EXAMINE THE EFFECTS ON THE COMMUNITY OF A SPENT FUEL POOL ACCIDENT THAT CAN RESULT FROM A CRITICALITY ACCIDENT AND A LOSS OF COOLANT WATER ACCIDENT. I ASK THAT THIS ASSESSMENT WILL INCLUDE OTHER POSSIBLE METHODS OF STORAGE THAT DO NOT HAVE RISKS THAT CAN LEAD TO A RELEASE OF THE RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS THAT ARE NOW OR WILL BE STORED ON THE SITE OF THE NUCLEAR POWER PLANT.

I AM A RESIDENT OF NEW LONDON COUNTY, CONNECTICUT AND HEREBY DEPOSE AND STATE:

1. I am associated with Co-OPERATIVE CITIZEN'S MONITORING NETWORK (CCMN), (OR EARTHVISION, INC.) AND I AUTHORIZE CCMN (OR EARTHVISION) TO REPRESENT MY INTERESTS IN THE MATTER BEFORE THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION IN PROCEEDINGS CONCERNING THE SPENT FUEL POOLS AT MILLSTONE NUCLEAR POWER PLANT IN WATERFORD, NEW LONDON COUNTY, CONNECTICUT.

2. MY HOME ADDRESS IS 17 LAUREL ST WTFD
WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 3 MILES WEST (DIRECTION
I.E. SOUTH) OF THE MILLSTONE POWER STATION.

3. MY FAMILY'S SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER DERIVES FROM SURFACE
RESERVOIRS [PRIVATE OR COMMUNITY WELLS] THAT WOULD BECOME
CONTAMINATED [FROM RAIN WATER REPLENISHING THE GROUNDWATER]
FROM A SPENT FUEL POOL ACCIDENT RESULTING IN THE RELEASE OF
RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS INTO THE AIR.

ADDITIONALLY, THE MAGNITUDE OF SUCH AN ACCIDENT WOULD MAKE IT
DIFFICULT TO FIND UNCONTAMINATED FOOD, AIR, OR SOIL.

THE VALUE OF OUR PROPERTY WOULD BE AFFECTED AND WE WOULD BE
UNABLE TO SELL IT.

ALSO THE DOCTORS AND MEDICAL FACILITIES THAT WE USE ARE
WITHIN 5 MILES OF THE PLANT AND MAY BECOME CONTAMINATED
OR MAY BE UNACCESSIBLE TO ME OR MY FAMILY BECAUSE WE MIGHT BE
PREVENTED FROM DRIVING TOWARD OR INTO GREATER CONTAMINATION.

I WOULD NOT FEEL SECURE KNOWING THAT MY CHILDREN MIGHT BE
EXPOSED TO LARGE AMOUNTS OF RADIOACTIVITY AND THAT THERE MIGHT
NOT BE ENOUGH OR ANY WARNING SO THAT WE COULD EVACUATE IN TIME.

THE SCHOOL[S] THAT MY CHILD[REN] ATTENDS IS 2 MILES FROM
THE PLANT. THIS SCHOOL IS USUALLY [SOMETIMES] DOWNWIND FROM THE
PLANT AND MAY NOT HAVE TIME TO MOVE THE CHILDREN PRIOR TO
RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS BEING RELEASED. THE CHILDREN ARE SCHEDULED
TO BE MOVED TO ONE OF SEVERAL EVACUATION AREAS, ALL OF WHICH
WOULD BE AFFECTED BY RADIOACTIVITY IF A FULL RELEASE FROM THE
SPENT FUEL POOL WERE TO OCCUR.

Timely evacuation of children from schools, especially
Great Neck and South-West schools in Waterford could only be
accomplished if an adequate number of school buses and
emergency drivers/teachers are stationed on school property
at the time of an emergency. Waterford does not have the busses
to do this and teachers have not been trained for this purpose.

I urge you to expedite the decommissioning of the Yankee Rowe
Nuclear Power Plant in Massachusetts, in order to better
understand the economics of nuclear power.

Please consider the technology available from defense giants
such as General Dynamics, Electric Boat Division, for the
manufacture of components for the storage/disposal of spent
nuclear fuel.

THE EMPLOYMENT OF PRESENT TECHNOLOGY IN STORING HIGH-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE RESULTS IN THE RISK THAT A SPENT FUEL POOL ACCIDENT MAY RESULT IN OFF SITE CONSEQUENCES. THEREFORE I AM CONCERNED THAT THE PRESENT METHOD OF STORING THIS WASTE AND THE DESIGN CHANGE THAT WAS GRANTED BY THE NRC ON JUNE 4, 1992 (AMENDMENT #108) DOES NOT ADDRESS AND PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY, WELL BEING, AND SECURITY OF MYSELF AND MY FAMILY AND THREATENS OUR INTEREST IN A CLEAN AND HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT.
