PRESERVATION OF RECORDS ON THI-2 ACCIDENT

In response to your April 13, 1982, centeranduc. Itr. Frank Bowman, Assistant Inited States Attorney, U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), was contacted on April 16, 1932. After advising DCJ of General Public Utilities' request to have the MRC vacate its May 22, 1979 Order requiring the licensee to preserve all records related to the March 20, 1979 accident ir. Bowman asked that a copy of the memorandum and enclosures be provided to DOJ. I'r. Downan explained that the natter would be reviewed by appropriate DCJ officials, however, in the interim the position of DOJ was that the request to vacate the NPC Order requiring the preservation and retention of records should not be granted by the NRC, and the Order should continue to remain in effect. DOJ was provided copies of the stipulated documentation and has advised that they will notify this office of the results of their review.
