This is to advise you that the commitments we made to you in our letter of September 17, 1984 have been met.

- A. The SNM was moved from license CX-22 to SNM-910 by paper transfer, ZSX to ZSX-1 dated November 1, 1984.
- B. The SNM was shipped to Bettis Lab on October 29, 1984 leaving an effective quantity of 597 grams. With the addition of the CX-22 material of A above, the effective grams is 904.
