This special inspection by Mr. E. M. Kelly on September 13 through November 4, 1983, addressed allegations related to the design, construction and testing of the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station.

None of the allegations which were inspected were substantiated. Alleged were a number of instances which, although accurately described or correct in part, were not representative of a public health or safety problem nor indicative of any weaknesses or deficiencies in your programs. Records of activities inspected were found to be complete, even for those aspects of plant construction which were not safety-related and therefore not routinely inspected by the NRC. Design documentation, including drawings and E&DCR's reviewed, were found to be appropriately controlled and accurately representative of as-built plant conditions. Also acknowledged are the ongoing and extensive efforts of your Maintainability Task Force, in meshing design and construction with maintenance and access practices. Finally, the implementation of your "verbal" E&DCR authorization program, to improve support design and installation, was found to be effective.

No violations of NRC requirements were found and you need not reply to this letter. This report completes Region I's inspection and resolution of the John Huber allegations, which were publicly brought forth in March-April 1983, and discussed with the allegor in a July 13, 1983 interview in the NRC Region I Office.

Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
