NRC STAFF MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.711 of the Commission's regulations, the Staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Staff) moves the Board on behalf of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for an extension of the time for FEMA's response to Applicants' Motion for Summary Disposition of Eddleman Contention 57-C-3 until December 11, 1984.

II. DISCUSSION

On November 2, 1984, Applicants filed a motion for summary disposition of Eddleman Contention 57-C-3. This contention concerns the adequacy of notification of the public at night. Since the contention concerns the offsite emergency plans, FEMA is responding to Applicants' Motion. Pursuant to the schedule approved by the Board on November 14, 1984, FEMA's response would be due by December 2, 1984. Tr. 6840

On November 20, 1984, FEMA's Counsel informed Staff Counsel that one of the persons with the responsibility for responding to Applicants' Motion would be unable to complete his portion of the response due to

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
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commitments which necessitate his absence from the FEMA regional office. These commitments include participation in the emergency preparedness exercise at another nuclear facility. In light of this conflict, FEMA is requesting until December 11, 1984 to file its response. Counsel for Applicants has indicated that Applicants have no objection to this motion. Attempts to reach Mr. Eddleman to obtain his views have been unsuccessful.

III. CONCLUSION

For good cause shown, the Staff requests on behalf of FEMA that FEMA's time for responding to Applicants' motion for summary disposition of Eddleman Contention 57-C-3 be extended until December 11, 1984.

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
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
