Re: NORTHEAST NUCLEAR ENERGY COMPANY, et. al., (Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit 2), Docket No. 50-336 OLA, ASLEP No. 92-665-02-OLA:

Please be advised that the petitioner known as EARTHVISION, Inc. has had a name change amendment to their incorporation documents denied by the state of CT due to the fact that the name is already in use. The original incorporation name of the organization was EARTHCIRCLE, Inc. We have been advised by an organization in New Mexico that the name EARTHCIRCLE is also already taken.

Therefore, lacking an organizational name, I wish to continue the petition for a public hearing on this matter as an individual. As a rate-payer of NU, as a shareholder of NU, as a federal taxpayer and as a taxpayer in the State of Connecticut, I most certainly would be adversely affected by any accident occurring as a result of the design changes in the Unit 2 spent fuel pool at Millstone. A shutdown as a result of such an accident could increase my electrical rates and decrease my dividends in order to make up for lost revenues. Should a "State of Emergency" be deemed necessary, both my federal and state taxes would be affected. Additionally, health insurance rates in the area could increase to offset costs to the carriers by claims for medical problems resulting from radiation sickness of varying degrees, again affecting me personally.

I would also like to take this opportunity to express disappointment at the great efforts being made by the NRC and NU to avoid a public hearing on this matter. It does, after all involve a "PUBLIC" utility which has great impact on the quality of life of a great number of people in the northeast, either by producing electricity and/or by creating a risk of radioactive contamination of the biosphere. Neither the NRC or NU are aiding the current efforts underway by the nuclear industry nationwide to assure the public of their interest in real public health and safety. Public hearings are basic democratic forums for citizen participation in government. Efforts to block this one from occurring are certainly regrettable.
