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

Response

Corrective Steps Which Have Been Taken and the Results Achieved

Preoperational Test Procedure 1-PT-309-2, Revision 1, Section 7.12.3.1.C, which requires verification of the "Ready to Load" condition, was performed after the lamp circuit was corrected. The synchronizing procedure steps (Section 7.12.15) were repeated satisfactorily. A replacement copy of Procedure Interim Operating Instruction (IOI) 302.2 was placed in the control room.

Corrective Steps Which Will Be Taken To Avoid Further Violations

Training of Start-up and Test personnel was completed on January 16, 1985, to stress the importance of strict compliance with procedures.

Date When Full Compliance Was Achieved

Full compliance was achieved by January 16, 1985.
