22 that the Commission modify or expunge the footnote on a
23 Commission order of August 6.

24 Commissioners Roberts, Asselstine, Bernthal and
25 Zech have approved a proposed order which denies that request.

1 Chairman Palladino has disapproved the order.

2 Would you please affirm your votes?

3 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: I wonder if I could make a
4 comment. I think the UCS brought to our attention what they
5 considered an error in the record. I think if the error is
6 there, the right way to do it is fix it. That's why I vote
7 the way I do. All right?

8 MR. CHILK: Please, affirm your votes.

9 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

10 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

11 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: Aye.
