EMERGENCY RESPONSE DATA SYSTEM (ERDS) - IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE

In accordance with TVA's submittal dated October 28, 1991, TVA committed to:

1. An operational ERDS at Sequoyah Nuclear Plant by August 14, 1992.
2. AN operational ERDS with a limited data set at Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant Unit 2 by August 14, 1992.
3. An operational ERDS at the Central Emergency Control Center (CECC).

TVA has completed the required tasks to implement the above ERDS commitments. Although the final formal testing by the NRC contractor cannot be completed at this time due to scheduling difficulty with the Telephone Company, TVA considers that our commitments for an operational ERDS have been completed. The final testing of the ERDS by NRC's contractor will be completed after installation of the FTS 2000 telephone lines into the CECC has been completed.
