Gentlemen:

This letter is being transmitted to document a conversation between a NRC Region IV staff member and Waterford 3 representatives that occurred on Tuesday, August 4, 1992. The purpose for the conversation was to discuss an extension of the due date for completing part of the corrective action for Violation 92003-1. The violation concerned a Licensee Event Report (LER) which failed to address related problems with surveillance test deficiencies.

In Waterford 3's response to Violation 92003-1 (Letter No. W3F1-92-0150 dated May 1, 1992), Waterford 3 committed to revise UNT-006-012, "Development and Review of Licensee Event Reports, Special Reports, and Security Incident Reports," by August 5, 1992. The basis for the extension to that commitment is that Waterford 3 intends to include the change in a more extensive revision which was made necessary by a recent reorganization of site personnel and responsibilities. Waterford 3 requested that the scheduled completion date for submitting the change to UNT-006-012 be revised to November 6, 1992.
