The purpose of this letter is to forward a copy of the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) exercise evaluation report of the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station for the November 19, 1991, emergency preparedness exercise at the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station Site.

The report states that FEMA observed one deficiency and eight areas requiring corrective action during the exercise. We also understand that FEMA Region VI staff will work with the State of T xas to assure the correction of the eight areas requiring corrective action before or during the next biennial exercise.
