SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-445/92-30; 50-446/92-30  
(NOTICE OF VIOLATION)

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. A. B. Earnest and T. W. Dexter of this office during the period July 27-31, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

Based on the results of this inspection, one of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation is of concern in that adequate barriers and detection aids were not maintained to prevent unauthorized and undetected access to a vital area.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your

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
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response, you should document the specific actions and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.

The inspectors also identified a weakness in the implementation of your fitness-for-duty program concerning the potential for early notification of at least some of your employees selected for random drug tests. We request that you respond in writing within 30 days of the date of this letter with your evaluation of this potential weakness, identifying any corrective actions that you have either taken or plan to take.

The material enclosed herewith contains Safeguards Information as defined by 10 CFR Part 73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Therefore, the material with the exception of the report cover page which is an inspection summary, will not be placed in the Public Document Room. Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
