Dear Ms. Ryan:

This responds to your February 23, 1984 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for the transcripts of the Commission's January 24, 1984 meeting "Future Steps to TMI-1 Restart". The transcript has been reviewed and a significant portion of it has been placed in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. for public inspection and copying. Portions of the transcript are being withheld under Exemptions 5, 6, 7(A) and 7(C) of the Government in the Sunshine Act (5 U.S.C. 552b(c)(5), (6), (7)(A) and 7(C), and 10 CFR 9.104(a)(5), (6), (7)(i) and (7)(iii)) because disclosure of those discussions would interfere with potential NRC enforcement proceedings and would also constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

I am the official responsible for the denial of the material withheld. In withholding material, I have determined that the public interest does not require release. The denial may be appealed to the Commission within 30 days from receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, Washington, D.C. 20555 and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision".
