SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY

On February 28, 1985, NRC and applicant representatives met in Bethesda, Maryland to hear the applicant's appeal of the requirements on fire suppression in the cable spreading room. A meeting notice and attendance roster is provided as Enclosure 1 and 2 respectively. A transcript of this meeting is provided as Enclosure 3.

All parties agreed that the procedural and technical compliance with the applicable NRC regulations were being applied and understood correctly. After the staff and applicant made their presentation, it became clear a major issue existed with the fire protection for the vertical cable trays in the cable spreading room. In particular, the staff has a concern about the capability for fire fighting because of personnel access difficulties in that portion of the cable spreading room where the vertical trays are located.

The Director, Division of Licensing, noted that he would make a site visit as soon as possible to view the cable spreading room and the personnel accessibility to the vertical tray location.


