On August 20 - September 20, 1984, NRC inspected activities authorized by NRC License Nos. NPF-9 and NPF-17 for your McGuire facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection findings indicate that certain activities violated NRC requirements. The violations, references to pertinent requirements, and elements to be included in your response are presented in the enclosed Notice of Violation.

Another example concerning use of an inadequate procedure for nuclear instrumentation testing is identified in this report. This is similar to the examples contained in the Notice of Violation addressed in Inspection Report Nos. 50-369/84-21 and 50-370/84-18. Your reply to that Notice of Violation should address this additional example of noncompliance, which is brought to your attention by this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter, its enclosures, and your reply will be placed in NRC's Public Document Room upon completion of our evaluation of the reply. If you wish to withhold information contained therein, please notify this office by telephone and include a written application to withhold information in your response. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
