NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Tennessee Valley Authority Bellefonte 1 Docket No. 50-438 License No. CPPR-122

The following violation was identified during an inspection conducted on December 1-31, 1984. The Severity Level was assigned in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).

10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Criterion V, and the accepted QA Program (TVA-TR-75-1A, Rev. 8) Section 17.1.A.5 requires in part that activities affecting quality shall be prescribed by documented procedures of a type appropriate to the circumstances and shall be accomplished in accordance with these procedures. Paragraph 6.1.6 of Bellefonte QCP-10.30 Rev. 5 states in part that craft foremen/dual rated are to be trained and qualified to appropriate Construction Training Modules prior to being assigned to a new work activity.

Contrary to the above, as of December 11, 1984, activities affecting quality were not being accomplished in accordance with documented procedures in that an instrumentation craft foreman/dual rated was not trained and qualified to appropriate Construction Training Modules prior to being assigned to a new work activity.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement II).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violations; (2) the reasons for the violations if admitted; (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Security or safeguards information should be submitted as an enclosure to facilitate withholding it from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 2.790(d) or 10 CFR 73.21.
