Enclosed are executed protective agreements between CASE and Westinghouse, and CASE and ITT Grinnell. These agreements concern certain materials considered proprietary by those companies which were provided to CASE in connection with Applicants' motion for summary disposition regarding design quality assurance. By their own terms these agreements are "subject to the approval" of the Licensing Board. Accordingly, we request that the Board approve these agreements.
