Subject: UNUSUAL EVENT - TRANSPORT OF POTENTIALLY CONTAMINATED INJURED WORKER TO OFFSITE HOSPITAL

An Unusual Event was declared at Brunswick at 9:40 a.m. EST based on the transport offsite of a potentially contaminated worker for medical treatment. The injured worker fell in the Drywell and suffered contusions and a sprained back and left ankle. The worker was transported to a local hospital while still dressed in Anti-Contamination clothing and was accompanied by an HP technician. At the hospital the worker and his clothing were determined not to be contaminated. Based on the report of no contamination offsite, the event was terminated at 10:49 a.m. EST. State and local agencies were notified of the event by the licensee.

Region II discussed this matter with State of North Carolina Radiological Health officials.

Region II will followup with the licensee during upcoming inspection activity onsite.
