During the past few months radioactive packages addressed to our office:

Boston University Medical Center
Radiation Protection Office
D-604
88 East Newton Street
Boston, MA 02118

have been delivered to various other addresses in our Medical Center e.g., receiving docks. In one instance the 2 radioactive packages were mixed in with a pallet of other boxes. The receiving person did not notice the packages were delivered to the wrong location until he was breaking down the pallet for delivery. Receiving personnel then had to call Federal Express to come and pickup these packages for proper delivery. (Refer to FedEx control numbers 1130003898 and 1130004447 for documentation on these incidents).

Receiving personnel are not authorized to sign for radioactive packages. Radioactive packages on an uncontrolled receiving dock could be accidentally damaged or misplaced thereby jeopardizing the entire medical center's NRC and State licenses to handle radioactive material. Radioactive material packages should be delivered to their addressed location and not delivered to a receiving dock with other packages.


