The purpose of this letter is to request confirmation of the
closure of a followup item incorrectly identified as 50-416/82-06 in
Inspection Report (IR) No. 50-416/82-03; apparently, the correct number
should be 82-03-06. The item appears after paragraphs 4.1.1.5 - 4.1.1.8
and is concerned with equipment for sampling and analysis not being
fully installed. Also, it appears that this item was repeated as an
open item in IR 50-416/82-57 and identified as 50-416/82-57-02.

IR 50-416/83-57 (reference January 12, 1984 letter which corrected
the designation of the report from IR 50-416/83-53 to IR 50-416/83-57)
closed deficiency 82-57-02 and referenced IR 50-416/83-34, which also
states that the subject equipment has been installed.
