We have completed a review of the Plant St. Lucie Emergency Plan including changes made by Revision 14.

Our reviews indicate that certain elements of your emergency response plans are not consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.47(b), 10 CFR 50.54(q), 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, or NUREG-0654. These inconsistencies are detailed in the enclosure. For each deficiency listed in the enclosure you should either make appropriate corrections to the plan, or respond with a written statement of why corrective action is not necessary.

We request that a response addressing each of the deficiencies identified in enclosure be provided to us within 45 days of the date of this letter.

EMERGENCY PLAN DEFICIENCIES

The following deficiencies have been identified in the Plant St. Lucie Emergency Plan. The referenced criteria are from Section II of NUREG-0654,

- Criterion E.4. The items addressed in subparagraphs j, h, l, and m are not addressed in the plan or included in the State of Florida Notification message.
- Criterion I.10. The Plan does not relate various isotopes to the key isotopes in Table 3 of NUREG-0654 and does not provide relationships with integrated dose or dose rates.
- 3. <u>Criterion M.2.</u> The Plan does not list the individuals or their responsibilities or authorities who will fill key positions in recovery operations.
