On February 5-7, 1985, NRC inspected activities authorized by NRC Operating License Nos. DPR-77 and DPR-79 for your Sequoyah facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

Management attention is directed toward resolving problems associated with providing the State of Tennessee Emergency Organization technical information necessary for independent radiological assessment. This matter is addressed further in paragraph 12 of the report details.
