## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Wisconsin Electric Power Company

As a result of the inspection conducted on January 2-17, 1985, and in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

Criterion XII, Control of Measuring and Test Equipment, in Appendix B of 10 CFR 50, requires calibrated equipment to be used in activities affecting quality.

Contrary to the above, surveillance testing is performed on safety-related equipment using stopwatches for which adequate controls have not been established to ensure that reliable and accurate watches are used. Calibrated watches are neither specified in the surveillance procedures nor are programmatic instructions in place to generally control their quality.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement I).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
