NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of Iowa Electric Light and Power Company (the licensee) to withdraw its June 24, 1983 application for proposed amendment to the Duane Arnold Energy Center, located in Limm County, Iowa. The proposed amendment would have revised the provisions in the Technical Specifications to permit reactor operation up to 50% of rated thermal power with one recirculation loop out of service. The Commission issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment published in the Federal Register on November 16, 1983 (48 FR 52142). By letter dated February 8, 1985, the licensee withdrew its application for the proposed amendment.
