Subject: ELECTRICAL FIRE IN UNDERGROUND MANHOLE

At 2:50 a.m. on November 27, 1984, an electrical fire occurred in an underground manhole. The fire was put out by the site fire brigade using a portable halon extinguisher at 3:10 a.m. The Lacey Township fire department was called at 3:00 a.m. and arrived onsite at 3:13 a.m. The fire originated in a 19.9KV line, which supplies the "New Radwaste Building" from the 34.5KV bus in the switchyard. A splice in the 19.9KV line exploded in the manhole interrupting power to the radwaste building. Power was restored to the radwaste building at 6:00 a.m. from an alternative 19.9KV line. A member of the site fire brigade was taken to a local hospital for smoke inhalation and released.
