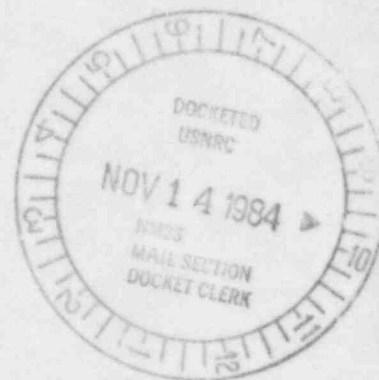


Enclosed with your license are other pertinent bulletins. Section 6.2 of Title A outlines posting requirements.

RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy and Radiation Control Act, Section 13-7-40 et. seq. of S.C. Code of Laws of 1976, as amended, and Supplements thereto, and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control Regulation 61-63, Radioactive Material (Title A), and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the applicant, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess and transfer radioactive material listed below; and to use such radioactive material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below. This license is subject to all applicable rules and regulations of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

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10. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Title A, State of South Carolina Rules and Regulations for Radiation Control; Part I - General Provisions; Part III - Standards for Protection Against Radiation; and Part VI - Notices, Instructions, and Reports to Workers; Inspections.
 11. Radioactive material shall be possessed, stored or used by, or under the supervision of: Regan E. Voit, Steven B. McCoy, Raymond Powell or Raymond J. Meyer (RSO).
 12. Unless otherwise specified, this license does not authorize the receipt, possession, or decontamination of equipment, components, or tools, use of radioactive materials, or receipt or possession of radioactive waste, directly or indirectly. Nor does this license authorize waste processing activities, decontamination of equipment, components, or tools, or receipt, possession, or use of radioactive materials at any other location in the state of South Carolina or any other location within the jurisdiction of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission or an Agreement State.
 13. Activities of the licensee involving the use of radioactive materials are limited to the decontamination, repair, modification, and storage of various equipment and components used by the licensee at nuclear power facilities. Radioactive wastes generated as the result of these activities shall not be stored for more than sixty days, and shall be transferred to an authorized recipient in accordance with applicable Department regulations and the facility's radioactive material license and acceptance criteria.
 14. This license does not authorize the receipt, possession, or repair of transportation casks or packages containing radioactive materials unless the radioactive materials are residual or surface contamination.
 15. The licensee shall maintain for inspection by the Department, records of surveys of contaminated equipment performed upon exit from a facility where waste processing activities have been performed.

16. A radiological survey shall be performed by the licensee immediately upon receipt of contaminated equipment at the location specified in Item 9. Records of such surveys shall be maintained for inspection by the Department.
17. Radioactive material shall be packaged and transported in accordance with the requirements of RHA 2.22, Transportation of Radioactive Materials, Department Regulation No. 61-63, Radioactive Materials (Title A), and Department Regulation 61-83, Transportation of Radioactive Waste Into and Within South Carolina.
18. The licensee shall notify the Department in writing sixty (60) days in advance of plans to discontinue the activities authorized by this license.
19. Except as specifically provided otherwise, the licensee shall possess and use radioactive material described in Items 5, 6, and 7 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated March 21, 1983, signed by Gerald P. Motz, and letter dated September 16, 1983, signed by Raymond J. Meyer.
