SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-361/95-25, 50-362/95-25 AND  
NOTICE OF VIOLATION

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. A. B. Earnest of this office on November 6-9, 1995. Mr. Earnest was assisted by Mr. David Orrik and two contractor personnel from the Safeguards Branch, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violations are a concern because seven zones were determined to be inadequate during testing activities and a compensatory measure for one of the degraded zones was determined to be inadequate.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. Because of the on-the-spot correction of the compensatory measures problem, no reply to Violation B is required. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. Your response may reference or include previous docketed correspondence, if the correspondence adequately addresses the required response. After reviewing

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
your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.

The material enclosed herewith contains Safeguards Information as defined by 10 CFR 73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Therefore, the material will not be placed in the Public Document Room.
