1. Continued use of several radioisotope thermoelectric generators (RTG) in support of the National Science Foundations research efforts necessitates the renewal of U. S. Naval Support Force Antarctica byproduct material license number 04-19167-01.

2. The NSFA Radiological Safety Officer (RSO) will be relieved 1 July 1984 due to his imminent separation from the Navy. Pursuant to this relief and RTG custodial transfer, enclosure (1) is submitted for approval in accordance with reference (a). A new alternate custodian is also being assigned.

3. In addition, due to the transfer of several RTG's to the Department of Energy in the Autumn of 1983, the amount of licensed material has subsequently decreased. Accordingly, modifications to NSFA's license are included as attachments (1-5) of enclosure (1).
