NOTICE OF DEVIATION

Kansas Gas and Electric Company
Wolf Creek Generating Station

Docket: 50-482/85-02
Construction Permit: C-PR-147

Based on the results of an NRC inspection conducted during the period of January 7-11, 1985, and in accordance with NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), 49 FR 8583, dated March 8, 1984, the following deviation was identified.

A. Recycle All Licensed Operators for Emergency Classification Training

The NRC emergency preparedness inspection report 50-482/84-25 listed a significant deficiency (8425-90) concerning the recycling of licensed operators through emergency classification training.

In response to this item, the KG&E Vice President-Nuclear, in a letter dated January 4, 1985, stated that the training would be completed as of that date.

In deviation from the above, KG&E had not completed the licensed operators training scheduled for January 4, 1985, as of January 7, 1985. Further, the licensee could not produce appropriate training records for 4 additional licensed operator personnel by January 11, 1985.

In response to the above deviation, the Senior Vice President-Nuclear, in a letter dated January 11, 1985, responded to the deviation describing corrective actions and action to preclude further deviation from commitments made to the Commission.

The NRC inspector reviewed the KG&E response prior to departing the site; therefore, no additional response is required for the above deviation.
