First of all, where and how often will Radioactive materials be shipped from Clinton Power Station? What qualifications/restrictions are required ~~of~~^{for} the people who will be hauling the material? Are the people who haul the material insured? If so, what is the minimum liability they must carry. ~~Is~~^{Is} the equipment used to haul the material subject to any special inspections or test requirements? Are they required to carry any special equipment in case of emergency? What type of ~~wrap~~ packaging will be used by the Power Station? Is there a Quality Insurance program for packaging and hauling the material? What type of security is used to prevent this material from being misused? These are some of the questions/concerns I have about Radioactive Material being transported so near my home. I would appreciate all the literature available on this subject.
