SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO IMPORT 1600 KILOGRAMS OF
LOW-ENRICHED URANIUM FROM VARIOUS COUNTRIES -
ISNM84012

On October 30, 1984, International Energy Associates, Ltd., applied for a license authorizing the import of 1600 kilograms of uranium enriched to a maximum of 4.0% U-235, as UF_6 for chemical and isotope analysis by Ledoux and Company. The material will be shipped from the U.K., The Federal Republic of Germany, and/or The Netherlands.

The staff has concluded that the proposed import meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act as amended, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States or constitute an unreasonable risk to the public health and safety.
