By letter dated September 14, 1994, Duke Power Company (DPC) submitted Request for Relief No. 94-02 from certain ASME Code requirements that were determined to be impractical to perform at Catawba Nuclear Station, Unit 2, during the second 10-year interval. The NRC has reviewed and evaluated DPC's submittal and supporting information. Our evaluation and conclusions are contained in the enclosed Safety Evaluation.

The NRC staff has concluded that certain requirements of the Code are impractical and that, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(6)(i), relief may be granted as requested in Request for Relief No. 94-02. This relief is authorized by law and will not endanger life or property, or the common defense and security, and is otherwise in the public interest, given due consideration to the burden upon DPC that could result if the requirements were imposed on your facility.
