SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF DISCUSSIONS WITH PHILADELPHIA ELECTRIC COMPANY  
ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF LNR REQUIREMENTS IN LIMITING RISK

### Introduction

On March 6, 1985, the staff along with its consultants, Battelle-Northwest Laboratory, met with representatives of the Philadelphia Electric Company (the licensee) in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to seek the licensee's comments and suggestions relative to the NRC efforts to review existing regulatory requirements. The purpose of this review is to determine the effectiveness of the NRC requirements in limiting risk. The list of participants is included as Enclosure 1.

### Discussion

The staff requested by letter dated January 30, 1985 participation from the licensee in the first phase of its program on "Effectiveness of LWR Regulatory Requirements in Limiting Risk." Battelle-Northwest will prepare a follow-up report/questionnaire documenting the participation of all groups interviewed by the NRC staff. Their report will be sent to all participants for their review as well as to all other interested parties. A brief summary of some of the concerns expressed by the licensee are highlighted below:

- o Certain NUREG-0737 items appear to have specific applications for only one type of reactor (e.g., PWRs) but other reactor types have been asked to conform (e.g., BWRs).
- o Certain generic issues have been resolved by requiring hardware modifications where as this approach appears not to be warranted for some plants.
- o Other general areas of concern mentioned by the licensee included Appendix R modifications, pipe whip restraints, reduction in requirements being added to the Technical Specifications, and Technical Specifications in general.
