FOLLOWUP ON ORDER PROHIBITING INVOLVEMENT IN NRC-LICENSED

ACTIVITIES

Dear Mr. Minnick:

On December 22, 1995, an Order Prohibiting Involvement in NRC-Licensed Activities was issued to you based on your violation of 10 CFR 50.5 of the Commission's regulations. The order prohibits you from engaging in NRC-licensed activities for one year from the date of the order and requires, for an additional year, that you notify the NRC of acceptance of any employment offer involving NRC-licensed activities. The order required that you respond within twenty days of the date of the order.

As of today, the NRC has not received a reply to the order. In accordance with Section V of the order, in the absence of a request for a hearing within twenty days of the order, the provisions of the order will be final without further proceedings. Therefore, in light of your apparent failure to respond, the provisions of the order are considered to be final.
