Gentlemen:

The subject license was issued to The Bendix Corporation to allow storage of missiles containing HK-31A magnesium alloy (containing 2.5 - 4.0% thorium) and HM-21A magnesium alloy (containing 1.5 - 2.5% thorium) and to allow minor modification of these magnesium-thorium alloy parts. The license limits the maximum amounts of thorium source material in our possession at any one time to 484 kilograms, which is the amount present in 200 missiles.

By contract with the Department of Navy, Naval Air Systems Command, Bendix is to inspect, prepare for storage, and store a large quantity of missile wings not provided for under the current license. As a result, it is requested to increase the quantity of thorium allowed to be stored and modified in our present facilities. Due to the license expiration date of January 31, 1984, we request that License STB 286 be reissued to allow storage at the two Bendixoperated facilities of up to 1,230 kilograms of thorium (as HK-31A and HM-21A magnesium-thorium alloy), which is the amount present in 200 missiles, and 1000 missile wings, and to continue to allow minor modification of the magnesium-thorium parts at our main facility.
