Dear Ms. Bell:

This is a second partial response to your letter dated February 8, 1984 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of documents pertaining to:

1. The NRC Staff's decision(s) to offer opportunity for a prior hearing for proposed operating license amendments to eleven nuclear reactors applying for a revision to their technical specifications which would allow operation with one (or, n-1) recirculation loop out of service. These include, for example, "Power Authority of the State of New York; Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License and Opportunity for Prior Hearing", 48 FR 52998, November 23, 1983.
2. Outstanding requests for review of amendments authorizing revisions to technical specifications to allow operation with one recirculation loop out of service.

The documents listed on Appendix B are already available in the PDR. You may request copies of these documents from the PDR by referring to their accession numbers as indicated on the appendix.

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
