Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. P. R. Wohld of this office during March 18-22, 1985, of activities at Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating License Nos. DPR-29 and DPR-30 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. N. Kalivianakis and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in non-compliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.
