Justification of Single Failure Assumption for Boron Injection Tank (BIT) Boron Reduction Analysis

Reference: Letter to B. D. Withers, PGE, from J. R. Miller, NRC, Dated April 25, 1984.

The purpose of this letter is to further clarify the PGE response to Question 6 of the reference letter related to the single failure assumptions for the Trojan BIT 'oron reduction analysis. The following attachments, provided by Westinghouse, consist of:
