In its Brief on Appeal From Partial Initial Decision, Citizens Concerned About Nuclear Power expressed a concern in its introduction about how the ASLB in this proceeding was using its Partial Initial Decision to severely restrict the issues to be heard in Phase II of this proceeding. CCANP's worst fears were realized in the ASLB Fifth Prehearing Conference Order (Consideration of Issues for Phase II) dated November 16, 1984.
