PROBLEMS/VIOLATIONS OF NRC REGULATIONS

Office of Investigations (OI) procedures call for periodic review of cases within its inventory to identify those warranting administrative closure. This case has been reviewed and is being administratively closed by OI due to lack of resources. We are forwarding our report on this case to you for your further review and whatever action you deem appropriate through the normal inspection program.
